Gem of the Persian Gulf

Kariz-e-kish is one of the tourist attracting foci of the island.

Harrirah

The ancient town of Harireh is most probably the town that the renowned Iranian poet, Sa'adi, has referred to in his bookThe Rose Garden'. There are references in the works of Iranian and Arab historians to the location of the town on the island. These say that the town was situated in the middle of the northern part, precisely where the ruins are standing today.

Water Reservoirs

With the innovation of desalination technology traditional water reservoirs became obsolete. But, what remains of them is a sight to visit for tourists. The architecture of these structures is unique and very interesting. To collect surface waters, two such reservoirs were built in the Portuguese Valley in 1992. An ancient water reservoir is Payab that is over 2,000 years old. It has been restored and is now one of the attractions of the island.
